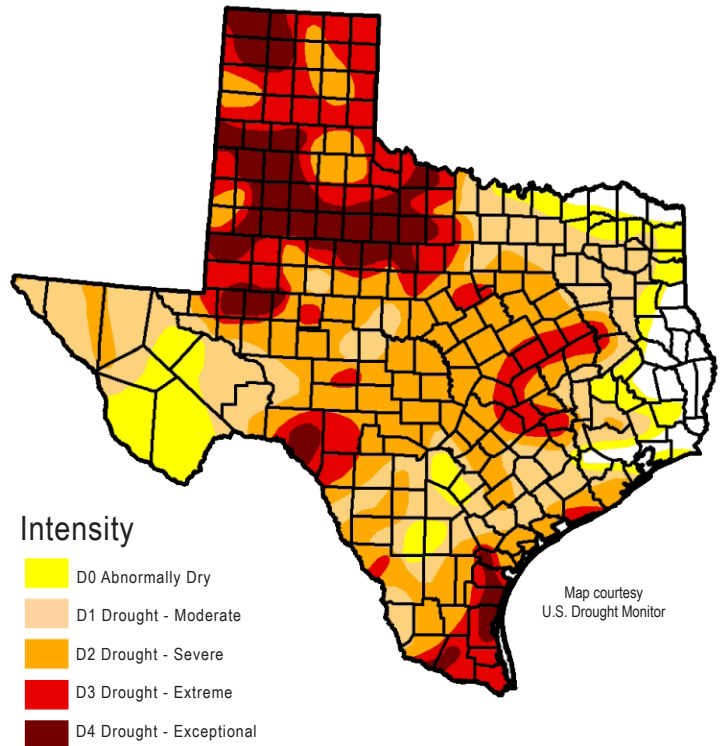


## DROUGHT CONDITIONS THIS WEEK

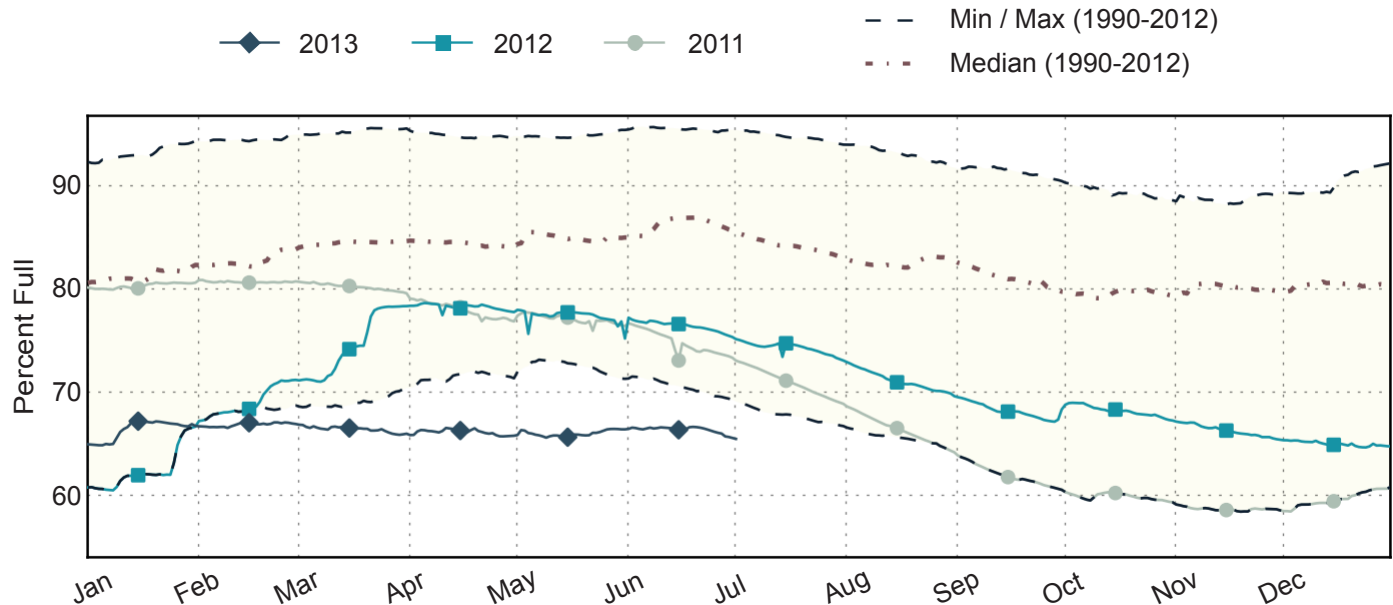
With record breaking heat last week, the typical brutal hot Texas summer we know and love is suddenly upon us! Drought conditions continue as the week before with a decrease in already low statewide reservoir storage. Looking for the silver lining, reservoir statewide storage has been relatively stable this year so far. Been nice to have gone up; glad it hasn't gone down...

### Current Drought statistics

- 95% of state currently in drought
- 95% a week ago
- 99% three months ago
- 90% a year ago



## STATEWIDE RESERVOIR LEVELS



This graphic shows this year's reservoir levels compared to the last two years and statistics for the past 22 years (through 2012). We are presently about 10 percentage points below last year and almost 20 percentage points below normal.
