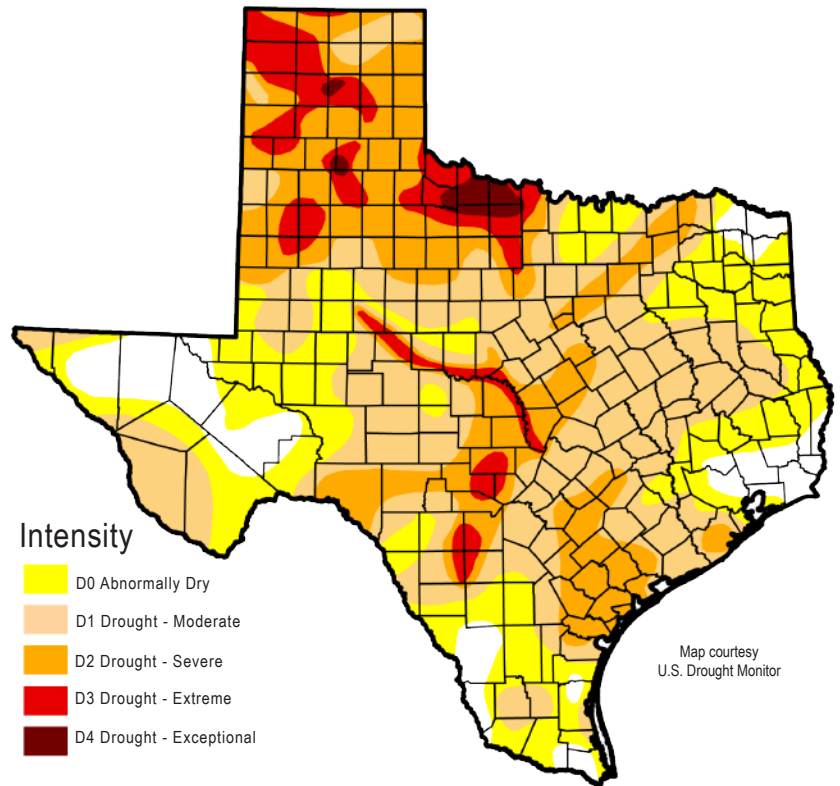


DROUGHT CONDITIONS

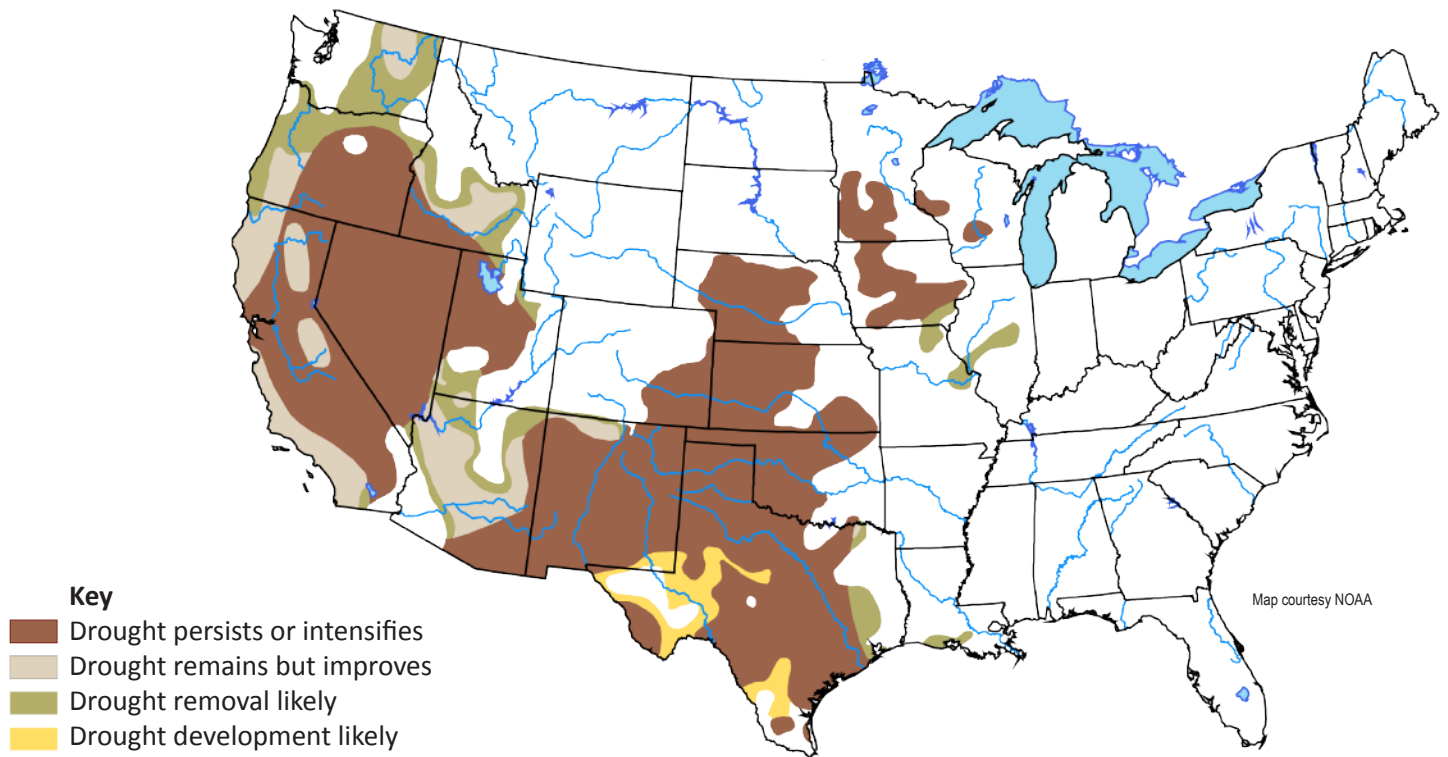
Mixed results over the past week: a slight increase (10,000 acre-feet) in reservoir storage and a slight decrease (1.5 percentage points) of the state in drought but also a slight increase of the amount of the state in the Exceptional Drought category. The latest U.S. Drought Outlook looks better than the last one, particularly in South and Far West Texas, but still projects continuing and developing drought for much of the state.

Drought statistics

- 67% of state currently in moderate to exceptional drought
- 68% a week ago
- 47% three months ago
- 76% a year ago
