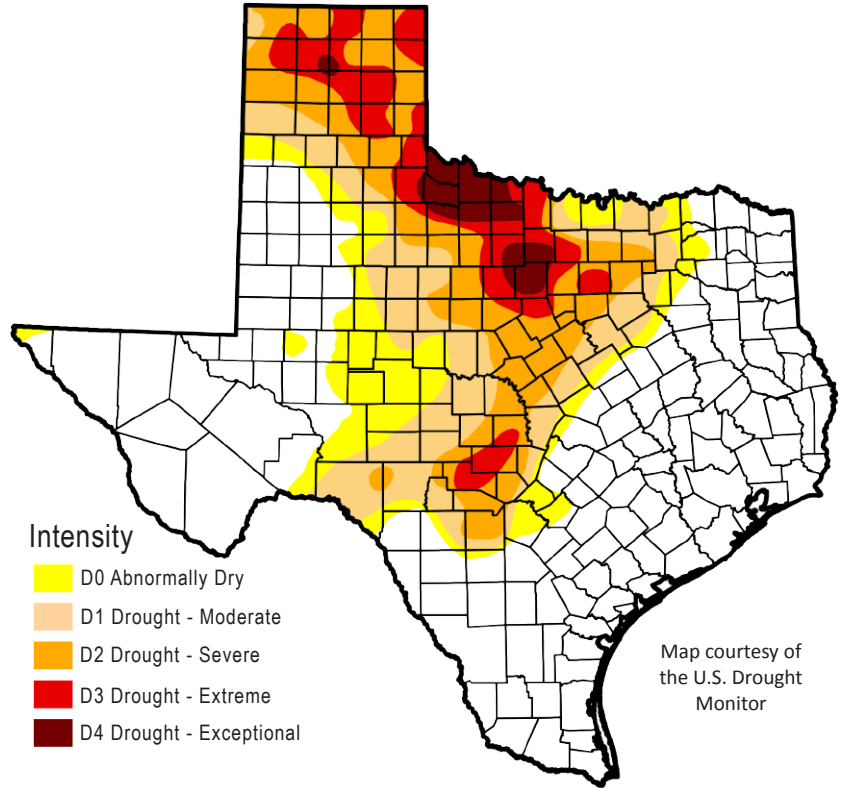


## DROUGHT CONDITIONS

Yet another great week for drought improvement in Texas! The amount of the state in drought (D1-D4) is now below 35 percent, the lowest since late 2010 when the current statewide drought started. Since the middle of February, rains have added more than 2.2 million acre-feet of water to our reservoirs.

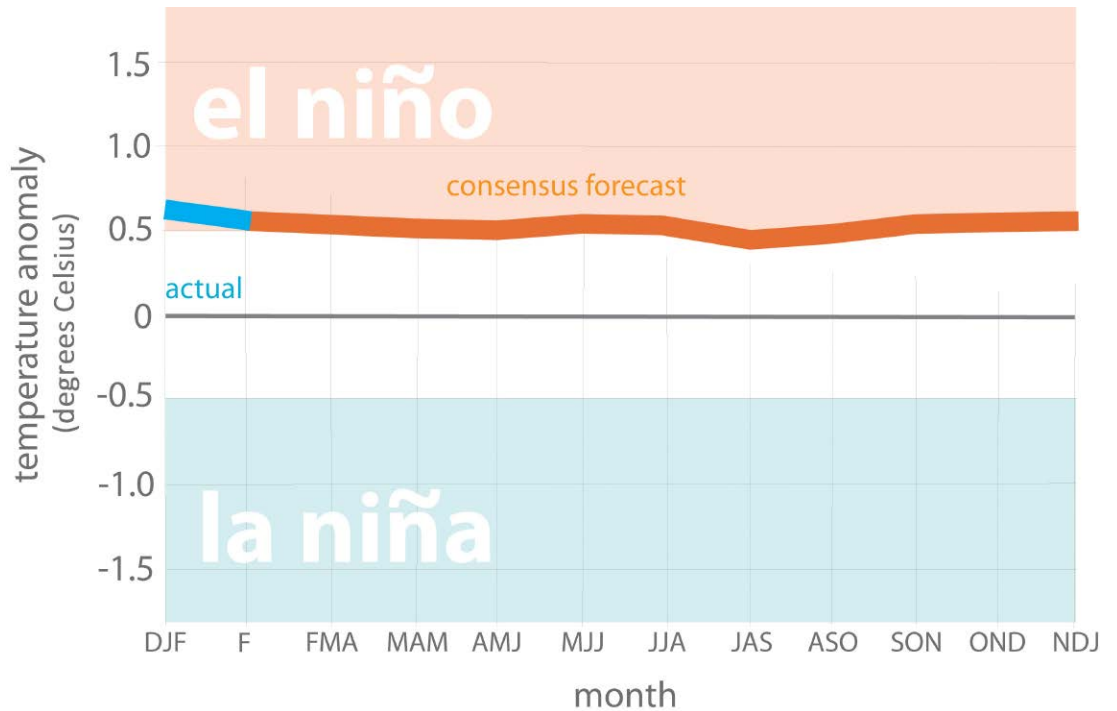
### Drought statistics

- 34% of state currently in moderate to exceptional drought
- 35% a week ago
- 41% three months ago
- 69% a year ago



## EL NIÑO FORECAST

There's a 70 percent chance for El Niño to continue through the summer and a better than 60 percent chance for El Niño to continue through the fall.
