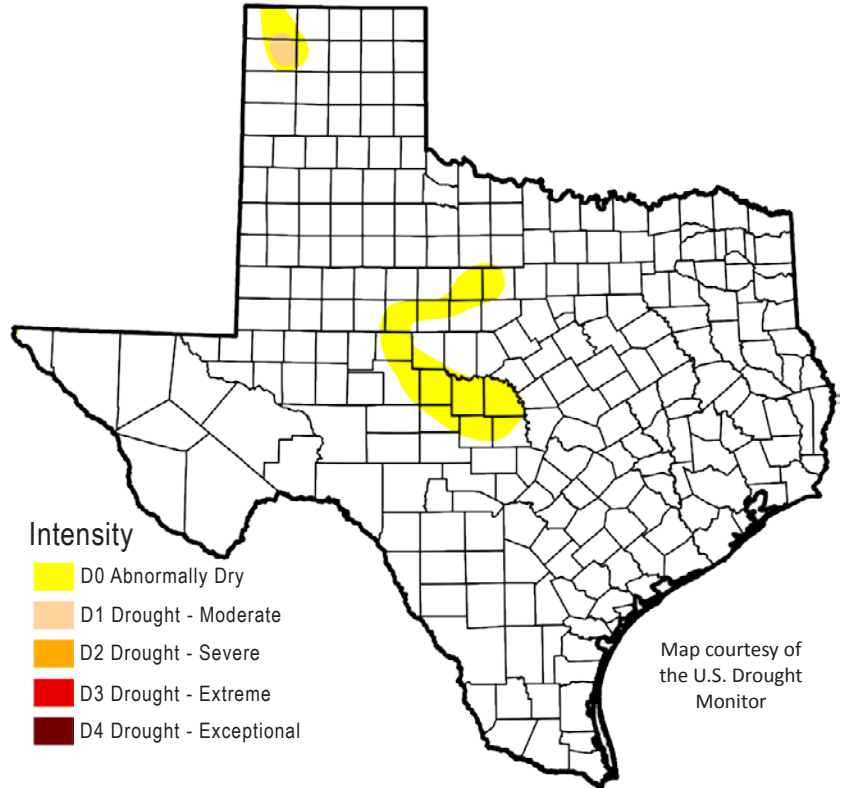


## DROUGHT CONDITIONS

Still a smidge of drought in the High Plains according to the U.S. Drought Monitor, but that is projected to be gone by the end of the month. Statewide reservoir levels are higher this week, but levels in West, Far West, and South Texas continue to be lower than normal.

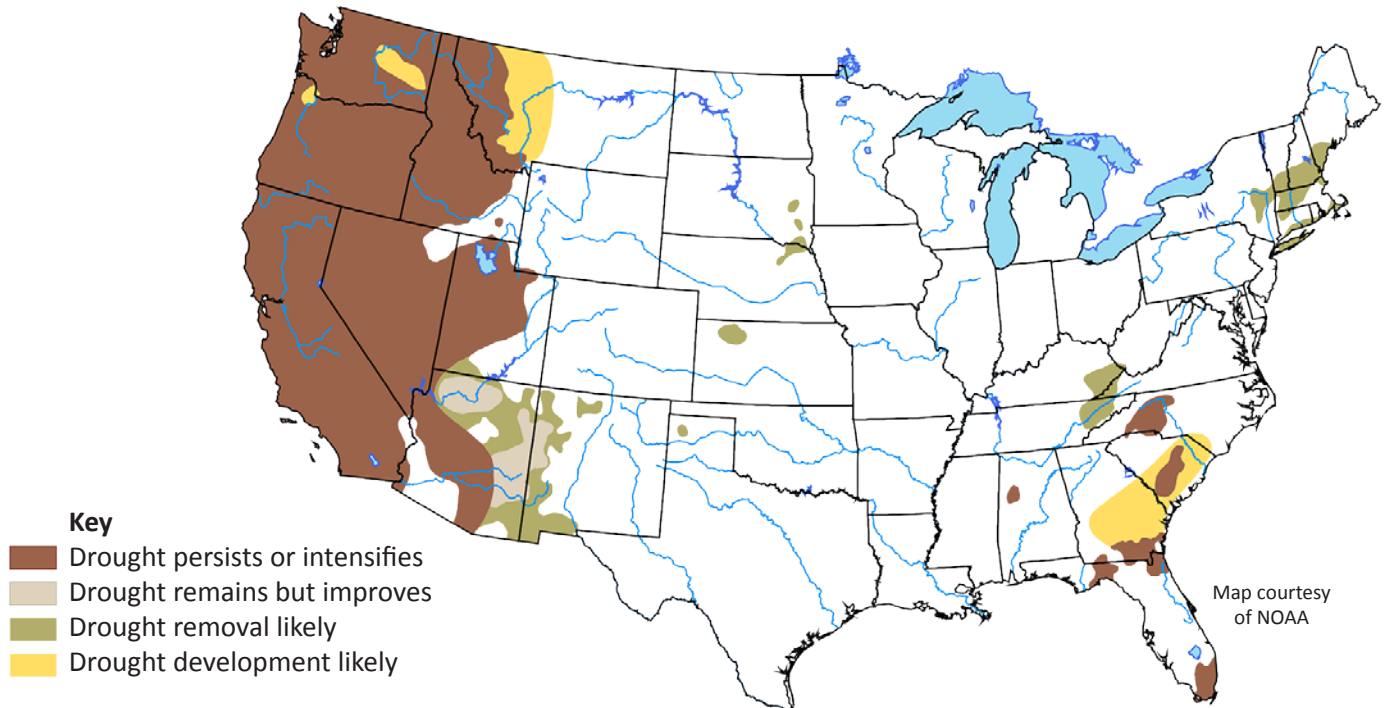
### Drought statistics

- 0.2% of state currently in moderate to exceptional drought
- 0.2% a week ago
- 37% three months ago
- 60% a year ago



## U.S. MONTHLY DROUGHT OUTLOOK

The U.S. Monthly Drought Outlook suggests that the last bit of drought in Texas is likely to be gone by the end of the month. The western half of the state is projected to be wetter and cooler than normal.
