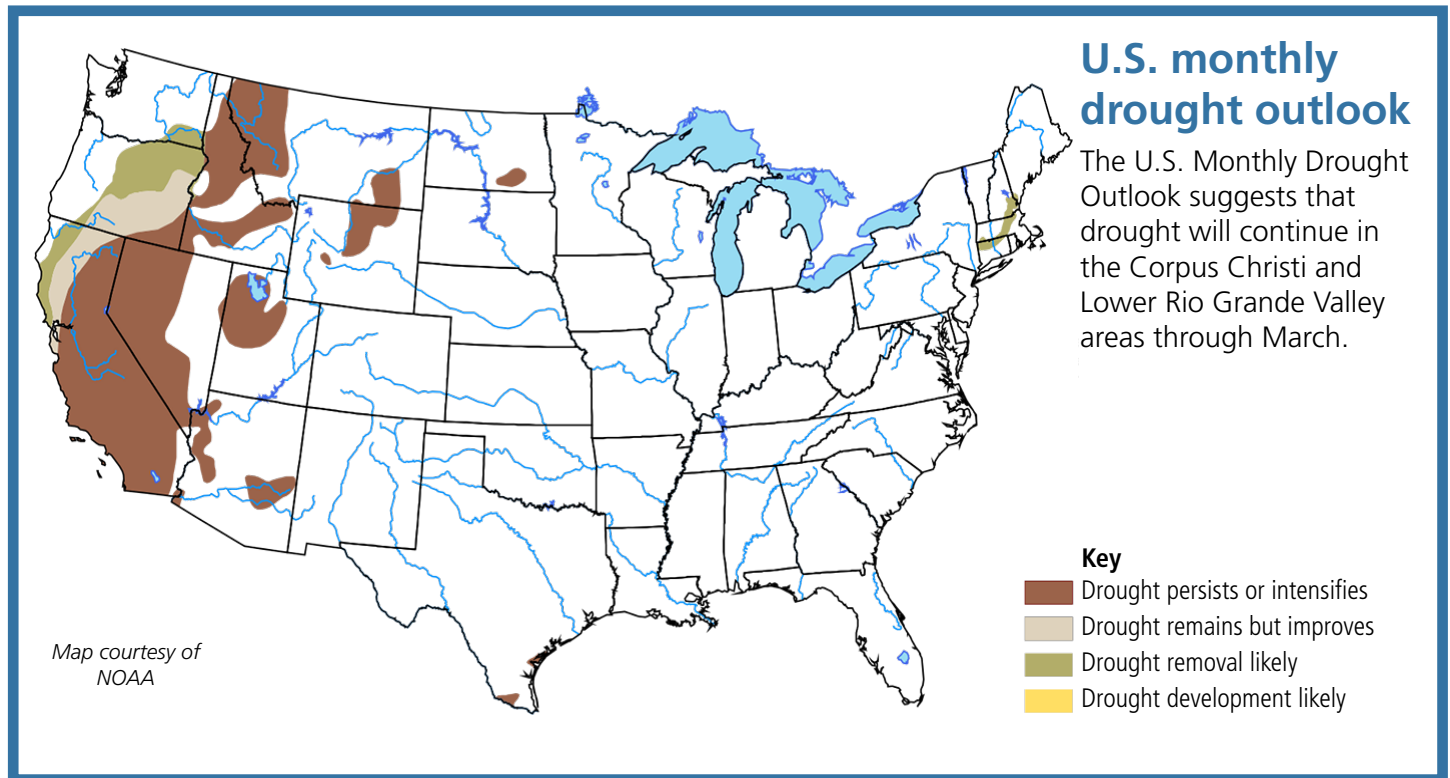
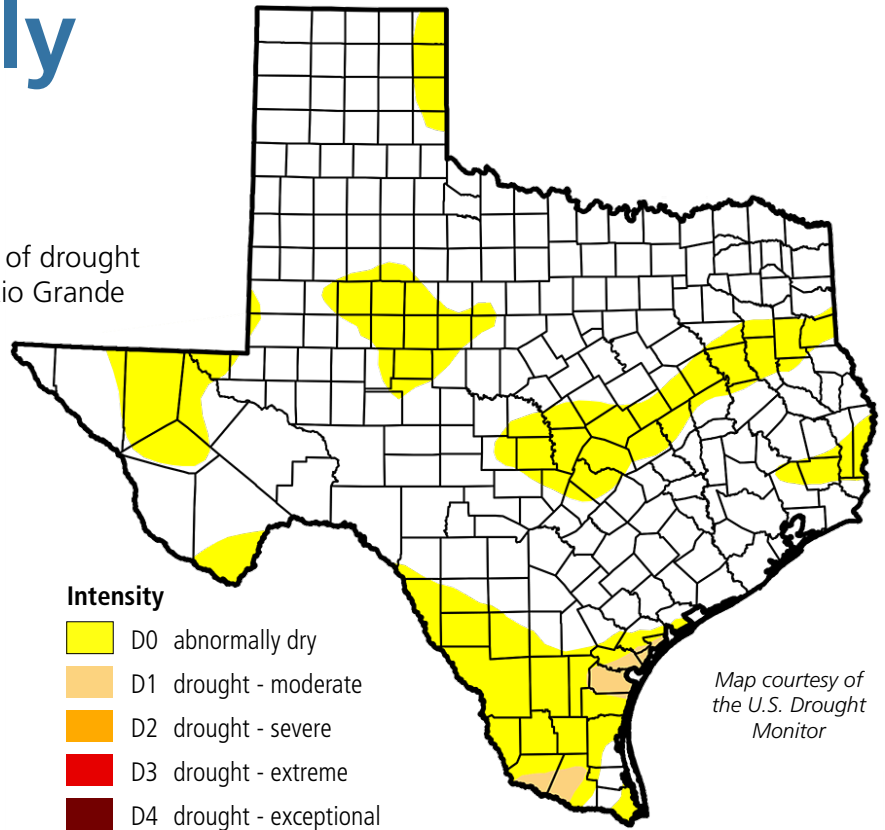

Water conditions

Over the past week there was a slight uptick of drought conditions in the Corpus Christi and Lower Rio Grande Valley areas as well as a slight uptick in abnormally dry conditions in the state. Overall, since the first of the year, statewide reservoir storage has been steady with a hint of decline. Typically, we see a gradual increase in reservoir storage through April.

Drought conditions

- ◆ 1.1% now
- ◆ 0.8% a week ago
- ◆ 0% three months ago
- ◆ 43% a year ago



U.S. monthly drought outlook

The U.S. Monthly Drought Outlook suggests that drought will continue in the Corpus Christi and Lower Rio Grande Valley areas through March.
