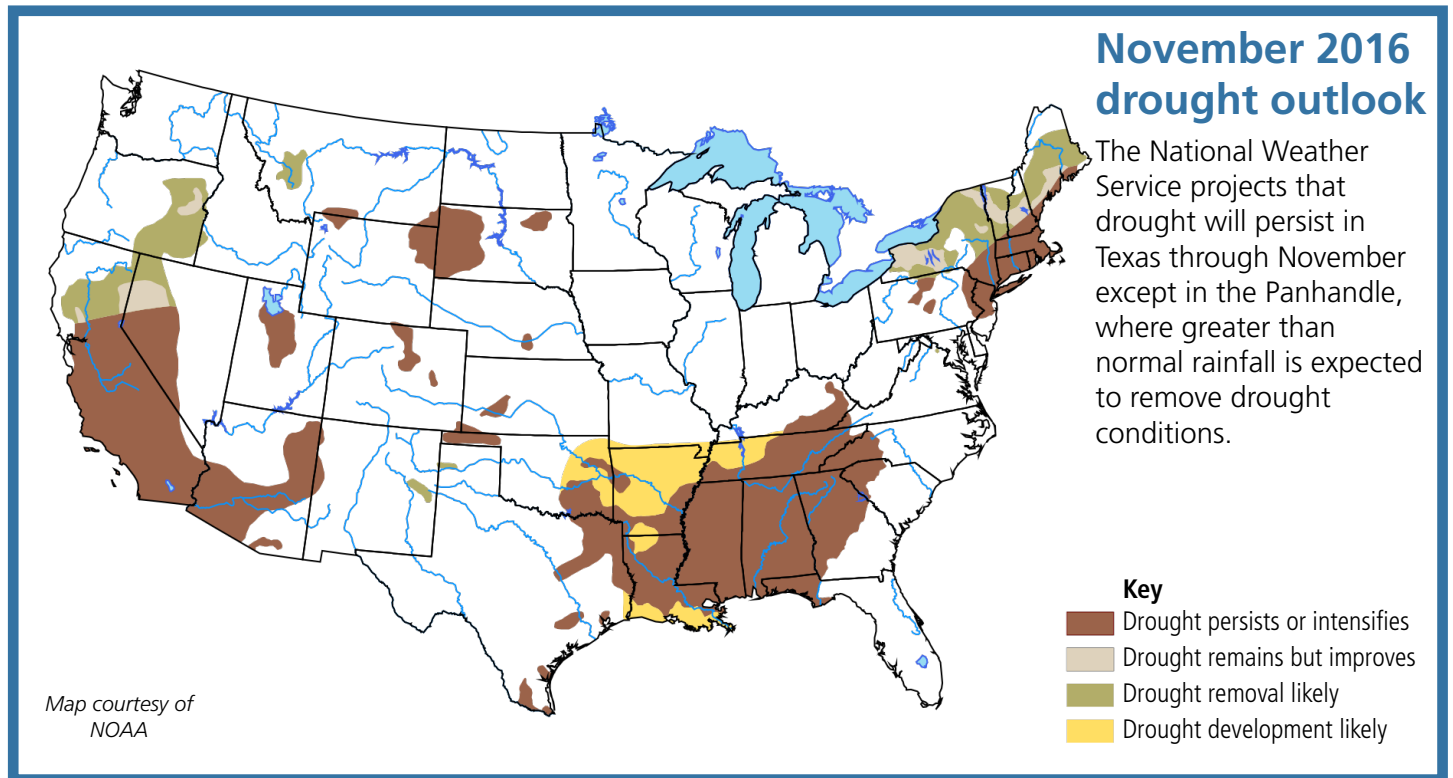
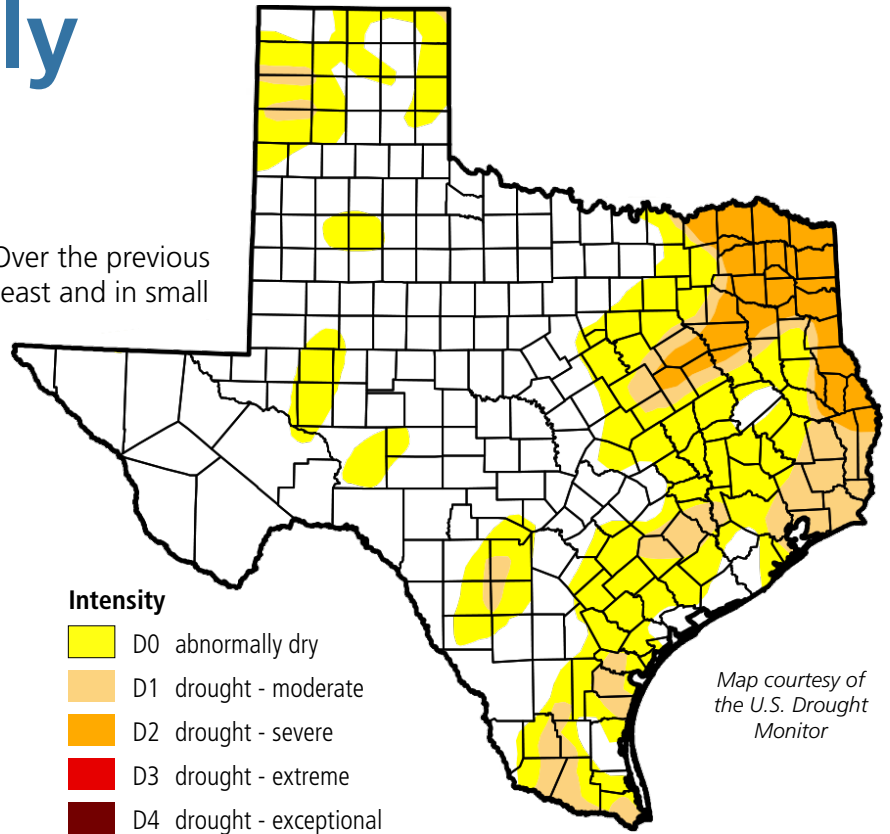

Clocks jump back; drought jumps forward! Over the previous week, severe drought expanded in the northeast and in small areas of West, South, and south-central Texas. The recent cold front brought needed rains to much of the state, with more statewide rains expected over the next week.

- ◆ 15% now
- ◆ 11% a week ago
- ◆ 6% three months ago
- ◆ 4% a year ago
