

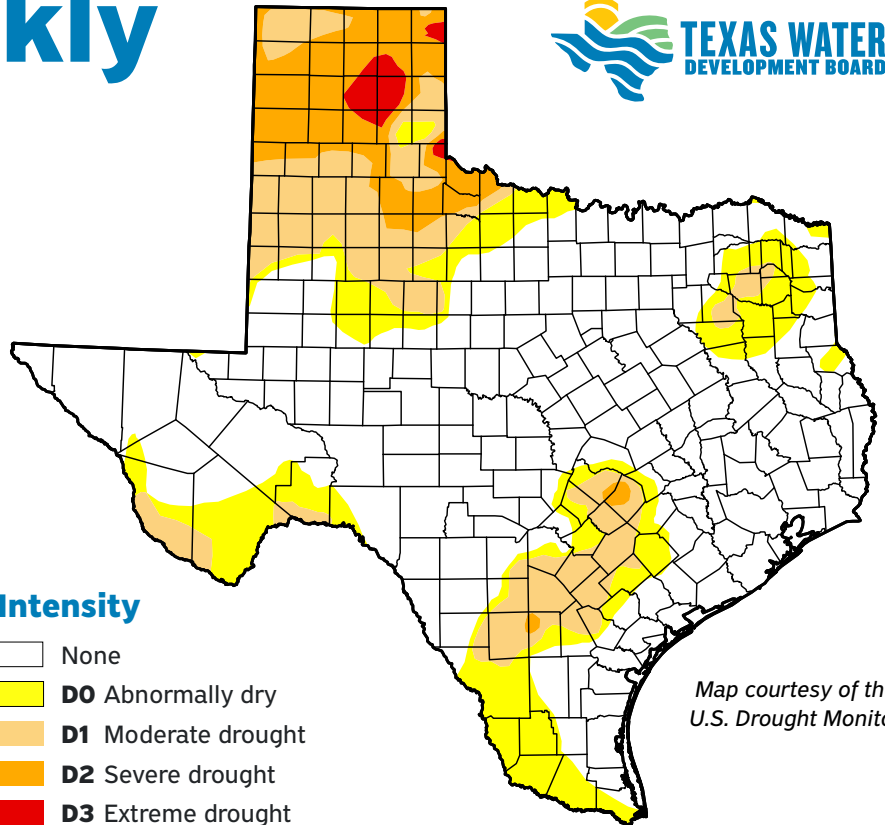

21% a year ago

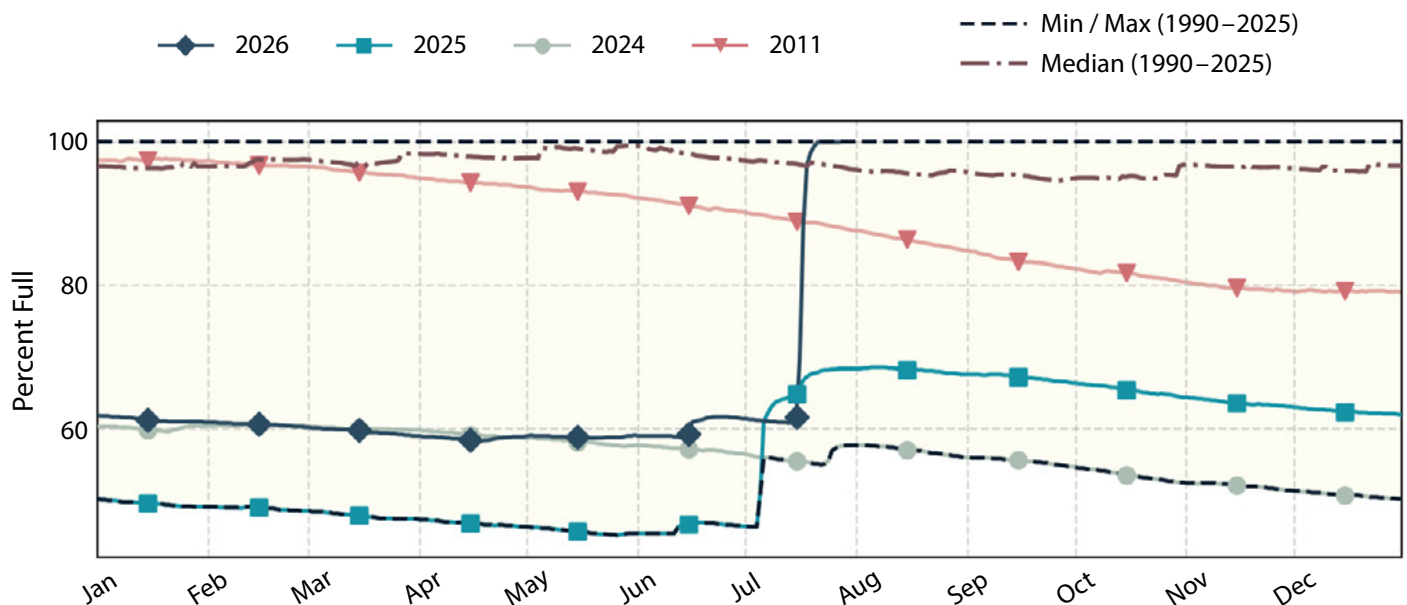

Canyon Lake storage

For the second year in a row, July flooding boosted storage in Canyon Lake on the Guadalupe River in Central Texas. Last year, the reservoir went from less than 50 percent to nearly 70 percent of capacity. This year's influx of stormwater filled the reservoir for the first time since 2021.



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
